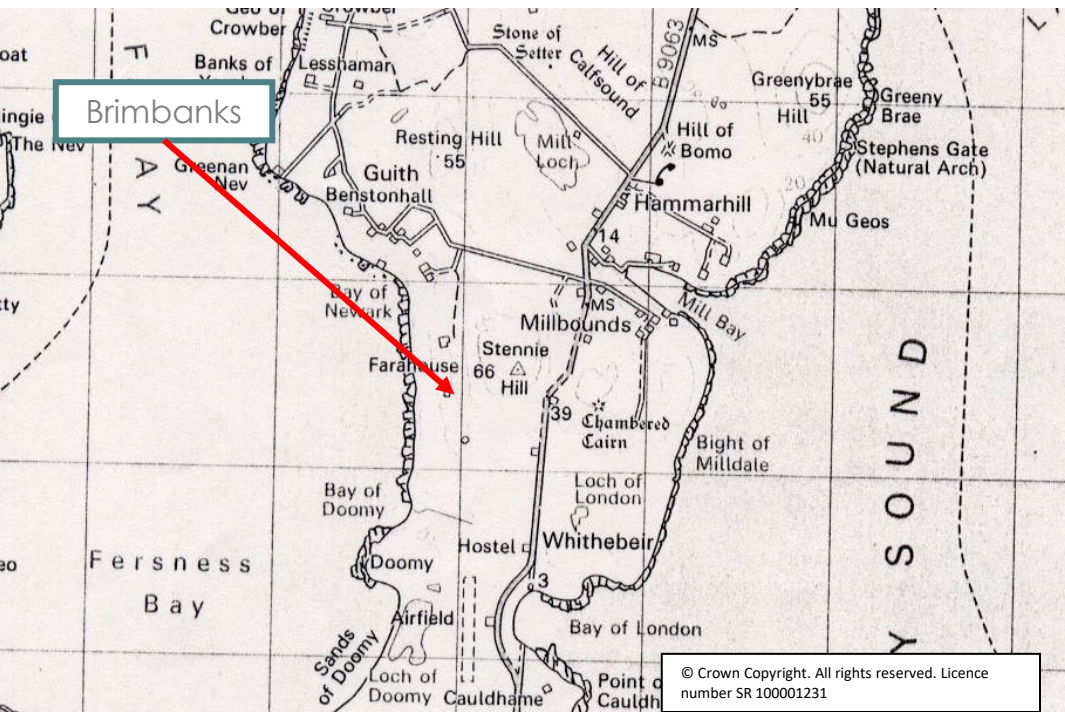

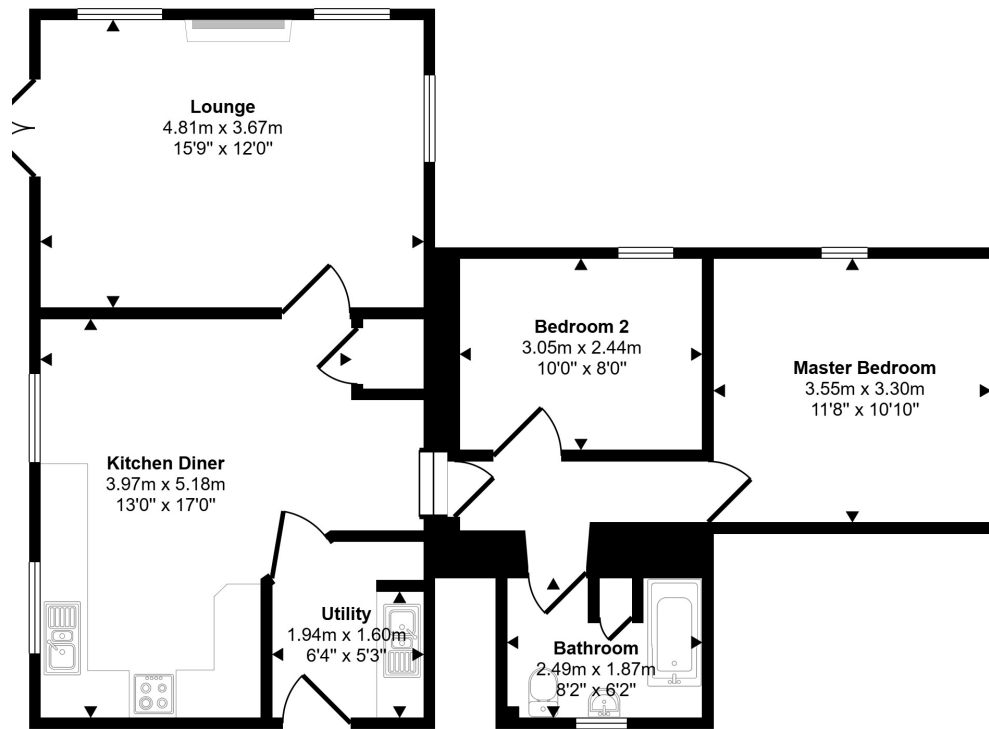
LOCATION
